SILENT AUCTION POLICIES, GUIDELINES & RESTRICTIONS

The silent auction opens at 1:00 p.m. and closes at the end of intermission. All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds on auction items will be allowed unless indicated. All items must be claimed the afternoon of the auction. The winning bidder for lessons and experiences will be contacted by phone to arrange for meeting times and locations.

Each item is auctioned "as-is" without warranty. Values assigned to some items being auctioned are estimates only. Items are not guaranteed by Cascade Winds Symphonic Band, which makes no representation of any kind, expressed or implied, with respect to any items offered at this auction. Cascade Winds Symphonic Band reserves the right to withdraw any items from sale prior to the call for bids. The bidder assumes all risk associated with their auction item.

THE BIDDING PROCESS

In order to make a bid, each bidder will sign up by providing a name, phone number, and email address on a signup sheet. Then a bidder number will be issued. A bid sheet is displayed with each silent auction item. All items are subject to a minimum starting bid and bid increment. A bid is entered by legibly entering your bidder number and amount on the bid sheet.

Illegible and incomplete bids not meeting the stated minimum increment will be considered invalid and will be voided. The highest bid at closing time constitutes the winning bid. In the event of a dispute, the Silent Auction Chairman will determine the winning bid.

THE WINNING BID

After the concert, *winning bids will be posted on the wall outside the theater.* If you are the winner, *proceed directly* to the bid table for verification, then pay for your item. Should the winning bidder fail to pay for their item by 5pm, it will be awarded to the next highest bidder. All auction items must be paid for by cash, check, American Express, Visa, MasterCard or Discover card. Checks should be made out to CWSBA.

All auction items are subject to expiration, restrictions, and deadlines.


Item 15: Quilt
